BIRDS:- Cardinal, Robin, Veery, Bluejay, Bluebird, Quail, Dove, Mockingbird, Thrasher, Catbird, Song Sparrow, Flocker Crow, Grackle, Phoebe, Woodpecker.

Angle (Left) Red and White Dogwood, Andromeds, White and Purple Lilacs, Azalea nudiflora, Halesia

Horizontal panel: - Kolkwitzia and Weigelia

Left of Map - Flowering Dogwood (White) - Right of Map - Sweet Cherr

Right angle:- Viburnums - Flowering Almond, Spiraeas - Flowering Crab Azaleas (various kinds) Wistaria

Right Horizontal panel:- Viola odorata, Erythroniums, Dandelions

North wall panel:- Myosotis, Fritillarias, Primulas, Bellis perennis Narcissi, Camassia, Scilla nutans, Tritelcias Iberis, Muscari, Bleeding Heart, Tulips, Lily of the Valley, Aquilegias Anemusa Large single Lilac bloom and large panel of Narcissi and one of Fern.
