A bond has been given on your account guaranteeing the re-delivery to the Customs of goods by U. S. Appraiser. On examination changes may possibly be made which may compel us to call for additional duty. If duty is overestimated a refund will be made in due course.

A bond has been given on your account guaranteeing the re-delivery to the Customs of unexamined goods not conforming to the various regulations. Goods should not be disposed of until packages retained for examination have been passed and released by the United States Customs authorities.
