The Oregon Bulb order has been changed so that 1000 Pheasant's Eye Narcissus are asked for for Crab Hill; and 1000 Recurvus (or equal) for the north side brick walk, etc.

Mrs. Farrand suggests that the 1000 Emperors may be used on the south side of lawn, as this was suggested by Mrs. Bliss.
