Wasn't that an effective conference we had last week? You asked for a comparative estimate of the cost of building the brick walk and ramp in

- 1) All brick
- 2) Brick and limestone

and these are the drawings I sent to Mr. McLeish today. As soon as he has been able to get these figures for us I will let you know the results.

As for the steps that go to the basement---we could bring these up to the grade we need by pouring concrete---and will plan to do this unless the cost of making the adjustment in limestone or brick is lower.
